You are invited to a trip to Sonoma County to visit Oliver Ranch, one of the country's premier private reserves for site-specific art. For over 20 years, art patrons Nancy and Steven Oliver have commissioned works that adorn the rolling hills of their 100-acre Alexander Valley ranch.

The pastoral setting of the ranch and the close relationship the Olivers have with artists in residency offer an alternative and "earthy experience" for the more than 20 artists represented at the site.

This is a unique travel opportunity for Director's Circle members since the Oliver Ranch is not open to the public and only donates tours to nonprofit organizations like the Crocker.

The Oliver Ranch tour is a bit rugged, will last about 3 hours and will cover approximately 2.5 miles and 600 feet in elevation change. It can be likened to a hike in the woods as paths are unpaved.

After the tour we will go to the Oakville Grocery Co. in Healdsburg for a picnic lunch in the neighboring plaza. Feel free to bring your own picnic blanket for a lovely meal outdoors.
